#### Road Issue - Armando Valdez:

- Armando first explains that he was just named the President of CSU Pueblo and wanted to ask the BOCC if they were ok of Mr. Valdez remaining on the boards that he sits on now.
  - o Rio Grande Water Conservancy.
  - o Board of Adjustments.
  - o Planning Commission.
    - BOCC and Mr. Valdez agree that he can remain on the boards and attend remotely when needed.
- County Road 12.5 in Ortiz has caused issues on Mr. Valdez's property, Mr. Valdez claims that the County has culpability negligence because the culvert was plugged and when the high water came it flooded his driveway.
- Attorney denies any culpable negligence on the counties part.
- Attorney Sarmiento states that the flooding was an act of God, and the County does not hold any culpable negligence.
- Comm. Garcia discusses the policy that the County does not go onto private property for any reason to fix or repair damage to driveways for any reason.
- County policy will not allow Road and Bridge to enter onto private property to fix or repair driveways, snow removal or even grading of private driveways.
- County Road 5.5 near Capulin that Mr. Valdez would like to partner of possible to improve conditions of the road.
- BOCC tells Mr. Valdez to discuss options with Donnie Martinez and Todd Peterson from Road and Bridge.
- Mr. Valdez discusses options with the BOCC using loans from USDA to fund road works, new buildings and other improvements countywide.
- BOCC might be interested in using a USDA loan to help fund the new Ambulance headquarters.
