**INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH
STATURORY INSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS**

DEFINITIONS

- 1. Verified Instructor means an instructor for a firearms safety course verified as a firearms instructor by a sheriff and listed on a sheriff's webpage.**

Concealed Handgun Instructor Verification

- 1. Each sheriff shall verify as a firearms instructor a person whose principal place to conduct firearms training is in the sheriff's county.**
 - a. Satisfies the requirements for verification.**
 - b. Pays any fee required.**
 - 2. To become a verified instructor, an applicant must:**
 - a. Hold a valid permit to carry a concealed handgun issued that is not a temporary emergency permit.**
 - b. Be certified as a firearms instructor by one of the following entities that has instructors certified by nationally recognized organization that customarily offers firearms training:**
 - (I). A federal, state, county or municipal law enforcement agency; or**
 - (II). A college or university.**
 - (III). A nationally recognized organization that customarily offers firearms training; or**
 - (VI). Firearms Training School**
- (3) (a) An instructor verification issued pursuant to this section is valid for ten years and may be renewed at any time prior to expiration.**
- (b). A sheriff shall issue evidence of verification to a verified instructor. The evidence of verification must include the date of expiration of the verification**
 - (4). A sheriff shall revoke a verification issued if the instructor ceases to meet the requirements for verification.**
