## Conejos County, Colorado Board of County Commissioners Public Hearing Notice Redistricting of Commissioner Districts

A Public Hearing will be held by the Board of County Commissioners of Conejos County, Colorado on January 24, 2023 at 6:00 pm. to provide comment or ask questions regarding the redrawing of Conejos County Commissioner districts.

Colorado Revised Statute section 30-10-306(4) states, in part, that the County Commissioner Districts occur after each federal census of the United States, each commissioner district must be established, revised, or altered to assure that such districts are as nearly equal in population as possible based on the redistricting population data prepared by staff of the Legislative Council and Office of Legislative Legal Services.

The Board of County Commissioners will consider two proposed commissioner district boundaries by the Conejos County Redistricting Commission. The Redistricting Commission created two maps to show two possible options for configuration of districts. These maps can be viewed at the Conejos County Courthouse at the Clerk and Recorders Office at the Conejos County Court House located at 6683 County Rd 13, Conejos CO, and are also on display on the County's website. A special website has been set up to show the previous configurations of districts, basic information about redistricting, and interactive maps that show in detail the configuration of the two options.
